Please listen to your child read this book as often as you can, ideally three times a week. Please make sure you write a comment in their reading diary and that their book and diary is in school daily. Additionally, the children can choose their own reading for pleasure book and change it as often as they like.

Please return any uniform your child has borrowed.

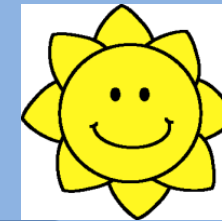
It would be a great help if you could make sure your child's name is in all their jumpers, cardigans and even their shoes.
