






Year 4 Spring Newsletter

English:

Maths:

We will be consolidating our understanding of place value, addition, subtraction, division and multiplication. We will also be working with fractions and decimals this half term.

This half term our History question is: "Why did the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings not get along?'

We will be finding out about the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings in Britain. We will examine how we know so much about them and we will become historians by using clues to give us information.
