English

This term we will be reading the story,

Math

We will be focusing on our mental maths skills, particularly the four operations and also looking at number, involving place value, ordering and comparing.

Spelling and Multiplication

Spellings are included in Friday's homework and are tested in class the following Friday. Children should be encouraged to learn all multiplications by heart and should be tested at home whenever possible.



<u>Science</u>

In Science, we will be exploring Earth and Space. We will be looking at the Earth, Sun and the Moon, along with all of the other planets. We will also learn about why we have the different seasons and day and night. The children will look closely at the Moon and its phases, and they will also have the opportunity to create a Moon buggy.

Geography

This half term Year 5 will be learning about the United States of America. We will be looking at different states-comparing and contrasting their landscapes and populations.
