<u>English</u>

This term we will be reading the story 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. We will be completing lots of exciting activities based on the text. We will also be recapping our grammar, punctuation and spelling rules as well as learning new ones.


<u>Maths</u>

We will be continuing to develop our Mental Maths skills, as well as completing work on factors and multiples, prime numbers, fractions and time. If your child cannot tell the time on an analogue clock, we ask that you support them with this at home as this will support their learning when applying these skills in class.

Spelling and Multiplication

Spellings are included in Friday's homework and are tested in class the following Friday. The children can also practise their spellings on Spellshed. Children have their logins for this inside their PAL. Children should be encouraged to learn all multiplications by heart and should be tested at home whenever possible.





<u>Science</u>

In Science we will be exploring materials and their properties. Throughout this term, we will be looking at reversible and irreversible changes and dissolving and evaporating. We will be taking part in exciting experiments and exploring the role of forensic scientists to discover the importance of different changes to states and matter.

History

This half term Year 5 will be learning all about the Ancient Egyptians. We will be looking at the different cultures and pieces of History that help us to understand how the Ancient Egyptians lived. We will also be learning all about the Egyptian pyramids, the Egyptian Pharaohs and the role of archaeologists. On 8th March, we have an Egyptian workshop to develop out knowledge even further!
