Reading books:
Reading books will continue this term. These will begin with picture books to help communication and comprehension skills. We urge you to read with your child 3-7 times a week.
We will change the book at least once a week, the books will need to be in their bags everyday so we can read in school. Please re-read books to encourage fluency and comprehension.

Ways you could help your child

Winter- Talk about the weather, how and why we dress differently for each season. What animals we see more frequently in the winter, why is this?

Circus - Explore the magic of the circus! Discuss the different acts like acrobats, clowns, and jugglers, and share stories, photos, or videos of performances. Talk about the history of the circus and the skills performers need to entertain audiences.

Superheroes - Discover the world of superheroes! Discuss what they are, their powers, and the stories they come from. Ask children which superpower they would choose and encourage them to create their own superhero stories or design their own costumes.

Traditional tales- Do you read any traditional stories at home for example, little red riding hood/ Goldilocks, which is your favourite and why?

Spring/Easter- Heading into the warmer seasons, how has the weather changed? Have you seen any new wildlife/flowers? Do you have any special traditions for Easter?
