Reading

Please listen to your child read as often as you can, ideally 3/4 times per week. Please ensure you write a comment in their reading record each time. Your child's books and reading record should be in school each day.

Your child will have 2 books.
They will be able to choose their own reading for pleasure book which can be changed as often as they like. Their second book will be changed once per week and this will be a book we have focused on during our shared reading sessions in class, which is part of our Little Wandle Phonics scheme.

In the front of your child's reading record are a set of tricky words — words that cannot be sounded out. Please support your child to practise these words as often as possible.



Please ensure all of your child's clothing is clearly labelled with their name, to avoid lost items.
